CONTENT OVERVIEW

Understanding Writing

Teacher aides will be introduced to the aspects of the writing process and the secretarial and authorial roles of the writer;

1. Planning for Writing - Supporting students to plan their writing. Considering purpose, audience, text type.
2. Composing - Supporting students with composing through conversation, clarification of thoughts, ideas and demonstration.
3. Revising - supporting students to improve and enhance the clarity and fluency of text to meet the intended purpose.
4. Recording - Supporting students with correct spelling and grammar choices.
5. Publishing - Discussions re - presentation and considering needs of the audience.

Instructional Approaches for Teaching Writing

- A continuum of support for working with writers either one on one or in small groups
- Teacher aides will be introduced to modelled, shared, interactive and guided writing and the necessity for a different approach depending on the needs of the students
- Conferencing - Secretarial and Authorial roles.

Features of Various Text Types

A practical 'hands on' approach to understanding the purpose, structure and language features of the various text types. One text type will be studied in detail.
